AUDITION REQUIRMENTS

Solos/Duos: 2 counts of 8 will be taught on the day by an instructor for the styles Jazz, Hip Hop and Contemporary. If you are auditioning for more than 1 solo/duo, you need to learn **each choreography block** in the styles that you want to audition for. If you are wanting to audition for a lyrical, tap or acro solo please see Jasmine before the audition date.

Current 2023 Elite team students wanting to add any solos will also be required to audition for those items. Any current students that do not wish to add any new routines, will NOT be required to audition existing routines.

Hip Hop Crews: Set choreography that will be learnt on the day.

*You will have 15 minutes (10:30-10:45am) conduct an individual warm-up before the audition.

**Students can then be picked up after their audition time. For example, if you are on auditioning for Solo's only you should arrive at 10:30 am and you can be picked up at 12:00pm.

RELEARSAL INFORMATION SOLOS/DUOS

1x 15-minute private lesson per week will be scheduled in for each student/duo. The times for each students private lesson will be given to them after successful audition into the Competition team. This one private lesson per week will be used for all the students solos/duos whether it be going over existing routines, creating new ones, or working on technique and strengthening work.

<u>ALL ELITE TEAM MEMBERS</u>

Students must be enrolled in the corresponding class for the style of dance they are competing in. For example: If you are doing a Jazz solo you must be enrolled and participating in the Jazz class or Jazz Tech class for your age group and level.

Students will be required to participate weekly in a compulsory Stretch and Strengthening Class.

SOLO

\$160.00 per term for a 10-week Term

This is an additional cost and will not be included in any class packages. This will be invoiced on your class Term fees invoice which will be sent out 1 week before each term starts.

DUOS

\$80.00 per person each term for a 10-week Term

This is an additional cost and will not be included in any class packages. This will be invoiced on your class Term fees invoice which will be sent out 1 week before each term starts.

CREWS

\$150.00 per term for a 10-week term (Term 4 2023 only)

\$200.00 per term for a 10-week term (2024)

This is an additional cost and will not be included in any class packages. This will be invoiced on your class Term fees invoice which will be sent out 1 week before each term starts.

ULTIMATE PACKAGE (FOR UNLIMITED STUDENTS ONLY)

\$250.00 per term for a 10-week Term or \$300.00 per term for a 10-week Term 1x 15-minute private each week

1x Duo private each week

This is an additional cost that will be added onto your existing class packages. This will be invoiced on your class Term fees invoice which will be sent out 1 week before each term starts.



OTHER FEES

Competition Administration Fee: \$5.00 per item & per competition you nominate for.

Registration Fee: Could be between \$20.00-30.00 per competition depending on competition.

Entry Fees: Could be between \$10.00-\$30.00 per item, per competition depending on competition.

Costumes: Sourced yourself with specification of theme or colours from choreographer, can source by hiring up-stairs or purchasing brand new.

It is hard to give set dates and prices for individual competitions as they are more set-in stone 2/3 months out from their date, but this is a brief overview of what would be involved cost wise.

Signing up to do competitions means you understand the cost and commitment involved and you understand that this is an optional activity to do.

LEBUR AND CONDITIONS

Be professional at all times in the studio and at all competitions.

Arrive on time to all private lessons and competitions.

Fierce Dance merchandise must be worn to all competitions.

Appropriate dance attire must be worn to all private lesson blocks.

Students must be enrolled in the corresponding class for the style of dance they are competing in. For example: If you are doing an acrobatics solo you must be enrolled and participating in the acrobatics class for your age group.

Bullying will not be tolerated. Please ensure you encourage other teams members and dance schools. Bad sportsmanship will not be tolerated at any time. If you have and issues or concerns at any time, please speak with Jasmine or a Fierce Dance teacher immediately.

If you have won an item at any time during your previous competition dancing years at any dance school, please inform us as this will affect which group (novice or open) you will be competing in.

Any items needing to be purchased at competitions due to forgetting/leaving items at home will be charged back to you after the competition. (For example, stockings or costume items etc.)

Staff discounts do not apply to competitions.

You must cheer and congratulate other students and competitors.

PARENT CONDUCT

All parents must abide by our policies and procedures and conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times during the competition year. If parents do not abide by the rules the student and parent will be instantly dismissed from the Elite Team.



TERMS OF PAYMENTS

Invoices for private sessions will be sent out 1 week prior to term commencement.

Invoices for competition fees will be sent out when competitions are open for entries.

Payment Options:

- Bank Deposit
- EFTPOS
- Bankcard and Ezidebit
- Weekly Direct Debit via Ezidebit

Direct Debit Terms:

- Weekly amount taken out via Ezidebit
- This needs to be set up prior to due date
- All bills will be scheduled until the last week of term
- Ezidebit processing fees and late fees apply
- Fierce Dance charges a \$5.00 fee for each time payments are rejected

All invoices are due 7 days from the invoiced date unless set up as a direct debit.

• Refunds – No Refunds! Be sure of the competitions you wish to enter. Once you are entered in a competition there are no refunds if you change your mind.

• Overdue accounts for private lesson fees will incur a late fee of \$15.00 after due date and will incur a \$1.00 late fee every week until the account is paid.

There will be no refunds of competition fees for lesson or for competitions after fees have been paid.

Private lesson fees must be paid by their due dates. If they are late, you will not be allowed to participate in competitions.

If competition entry fees are not paid by their due date you will not be entered into the competition. No late entries are allowed.

In case of a COVID lockdown we will proceed with training and competing online.

If you do not abide by the rules, you will be instantly dismissed from the competition team.

Entry fees/costumes for competition can NOT be put on direct debit.
